Congratulations! The Association for Behavior Analysis International (ABAI) has verified the course sequence you submitted for renewal from The Academic College at Wingate as meeting the 5th Edition, 225-hour coursework requirement for students taking the Board Certified Assistant Behavior Analyst (BCaBA) examination**. **According to our records, your sequence is located in Israel and therefore we request the following statement is also displayed on your website: Effective January 1, 2023, only individuals who reside in the United States (US), Canada, Australia, and the United Kingdom (UK) may apply for BACB certification. Please be aware that the VCS system will end on January 1, 2026, as the development of the BACB's coursework attestation process and ABAI's Tiered Model of Education better fulfill the purpose of the VCS system. Note that you will need to abide by rules described in the VCS handbook regarding verified course content and immediately notify us if a course does not meet agreed-upon requirements.
